System 1 (Measures 52-62): This system contains ten measures. Measures 52-53 feature eighth-note patterns in both hands. Measures 54-55 contain triplet markings (3) over eighth notes. Measures 56-62 continue with a mix of eighth and sixteenth notes, including some triplet patterns.

System 2 (Measures 63-71): This system contains nine measures. Measures 63-64 show eighth-note runs in the treble. Measures 65-66 feature a descending eighth-note scale in the bass. Measures 67-71 consist of various rests and eighth-note patterns in both staves.
